## CLASS EXPECTATIONS:

- Accept class invitations from your teachers for two weeks of classes at a time on the Google Calendar that is a part of your Google account and connected to your Hyde Gmail.
- The calendar invite will include a link in the appointment on the calendar to your Google Meet. This is how you log into your live classes, so following your Google Calendar is a must. Click the link and click join the class!
- Log into your class Meet and get your computer/camera set up **AT LEAST 5 minutes** prior to class starting.
- All Meet class periods will be recorded and will be posted to your Classroom immediately after class for those in other time zones. **If you are in the continental US, you are expected to attend the live class session. 100% attendance is required for full credit.**
- Each live class will have an exit ticket that must be done to signify your full attendance. If you are watching recorded lessons, be sure to complete the exit ticket and turn it in via Classroom for attendance purposes. Those live, in class, will also complete an Exit Ticket, and attendance will also be taken via participation AND the Exit Ticket.
- Turn in ALL work through Classroom or via email whenever possible to have a paper trail you can refer back to.

### STUDENTS IN CHINA

- Teachers will be communicating with students in China via WeChat or a non-gmail based email address.

### STUDENTS IN COUNTRIES OTHER THAN THE US:

- For those of you who have access to Google apps but are in a time zone other than the Continental US, all live classes will be recorded and posted to your Google Classroom.
- Each class period will have an exit ticket assigned at some point during the class and it will be important for you to watch each class period and complete the exit ticket for attendance purposes.
  - Suggestion- follow our Hyde schedule and watch each class recording in your own time zone to keep you functioning at a high capacity.
- Let your teachers and Disco leaders know what a good time might be for you to have video or phone call check-ins so that you remain connected.

### TIPS:

- It is more important than ever to do a little bit of homework each day to stay on top of your work. You are still being graded, and credit depends on your class attendance and work completion!
- Communicate with your teachers and Discovery Group leaders if you are having trouble or struggling in any way.
- As much as possible, set up in a quiet, comfortable space to do your video classes. Earbuds/headphones may also help you to hear better.
- Your basic daily expectations
  - Disco check-in
  - 3 live class periods per day
  - Work out/ active period
  - Study Hall
