Hyde Dress [Mondays & When Otherwise Scheduled]

WE START THE WEEK LOOKING SHARP AND UNIFIED

- Khaki skirt or Khaki pants worn with a belt; white or light blue button-down shirt worn with Hyde Tie; navy blazer or sweater.
- White or Blue Dress, or another nice dress or pants suit with a Navy Blue Sweater or other coordinating sweater or jacket.
- Dress or casual shoes that coordinate with your outfit. This may include clean, dressy sneakers.

Neat & Clean [Tuesday, Wednesday, & Thursday]

DURING THE WEEK WE ARE MORE CASUAL, BUT STILL STAY SHARP

Essential Elements of Neat & Clean:

- Appropriate Casual Skirts & Dresses.
- Khakis and other casual pants (including black jeans), worn with a belt. Bermuda shorts are another option in season. Pants may not have rips or holes.
- Button-down & collared shirts, Polos, Blouses, and other “business casual” tops.
- Shoes that coordinate with your outfit. This may include clean, dressy sneakers.

Dress Down [Friday & Saturday]

- Includes jeans [not ripped or with holes], appropriate T-shirts, casual pants, casual dresses, skirts, shorts, athletic dress, and leggings and other athleisure [worn with an appropriately long top].

Other Essential Elements

- Hats, bandanas, sweat bands, jacket/hoodie hoods, or any other head covering must be removed indoors.
